

FORUM: GENEVA COUNCIL

ISSUE: THE GREAT WAR

1. **Calls for** the German Empire to, when they settle for peace, agree to hand over:
  - a. the territories France had lost to the German Empire after the Franco-Prussian war in 1870, namely Alsace-Lorraine,
  - b. the Asian and Pacific territories, Qingdao, occupied by the German Empire to the Empire of Japan;
2. **Demands** that Austria-Hungary ceases its attempts of cutting unions between Serbia and Montenegro;
3. **Further demands** all nations possessing colonies to immediately retire their troops from other member States colonial possession, in order to:
  - a. avoid to expand the conflict to other nations,
  - b. impede the death and destruction of whole nations;
4. **Encourages** all nations to cooperate with non-governmental organizations that help civilians during the wars and emergency situations in wars, especially International Cooperation of The International Committee of the Red Cross;
5. **Draws the attention to** the ‘The Hague Treaty’ signed in 1899, which all nations ignored in this time of war, and calls for the enabling of the ‘The Hague Treaty’ by all delegations present in this council after the prior atrocities have been committed are solved and acknowledged, thereby:
  - a. preventing any war crimes from happening,
  - b. making sure the rules of war are being followed at all times;
6. **Further calls upon** the British Empire to continue to enforce the Pax Britannica to contain other future conflicts to preserve peace;

7. **Invites** the allies of the Triple Entente, namely the British Empire, the Russian Empire, the kingdom of Montenegro, the Empire of Japan, the Republic of Portugal and the United States of America to further aid the French Republic in the current trench war against the German Empire and its allies;

8. **Further Demands** the Ottoman Empire to:

- a. stop invading more regions,
- b. end the wars they are fighting at this very moment, under the condition that the French Empire and all other nations currently at war against the Ottoman Empire withdraw their troops;

9. **Further calls for** the participating nations of the Geneva Council to accept the Japanese claim on Manchuria to secure peace and economic growth in Asia;

10. **Endorses** the part demilitarization of the German Empire after the war is over;

11. **Strongly urges** the German Empire to be punished for their war crimes as stated in the 'the Hague treaty' because of their zeppelin raid on the British empire by:

- a. having the German Empire pay for the reconstruction of the Great Yarmouth and King's Lynn,
- b. calling for the council to express its detestation on the German Empire bombing civilians;
- c. further calling for the German Empire to express its apologies regarding the crimes committed
